United States of America — State of California.

To All to whom these presents shall come greeting.

Whereas under the provisions of the several acts of the Congress of the United States entitled "an act to appropriate

the proceeds of the sales of the Public Lands and to grant preemption Rights" approved September fourth, eighteen hundred and forty one, Five hundred Thousand acres of the Public lands were granted to the State of California, and an act entitled "an act to provide for the survey of the Public lands in California, the granting of preemption Rights therein and for other Purposes" approved March third, eighteen hundred and fifty three, ten sections of land were granted for the erection of Public Buildings, and seventy two sections for a Seminary of Learning, also the sixteenth and Thirty six sections each Township in said state; Also, an act entitled "an act donating Public lands to the several States and Territories which may provide Colleges for the benefit of agriculture and the mechanic arts"; approved July second, eighteen hundred and sixty two, one hundred and Fifty thousand acres of the Public Lands were also granted to said state; And whereas, the Legislature of the state of California has provided for the sale and conveyance of said lands by statutes enacted from time to time; And whereas, it appears by the certificate of the register of the State Land Office, No. 3694—issued in accordance with the provisions of law bearing date the Fourteenth day of April 1874 that the tracts of land of sixteenth and thirty six sections school land hereinafter described have been duly and properly located in accordance with law and that Wm W. Mullen is entitled to receive a Patent therefor;

Now therefore, the state of California hereby grants to the said Wm W. Mullen, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the said tracts of land located as aforesaid and which are known and described as follows, to wit: — — — — — the west quarter of the south west quarter of section

Thirty Six (36) Township Twenty Two (22) North Range Four (4) East Mt Diablo Meridian, containing Forty (40) acres taken in lieu of Forty (40) acres, together with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto appertaining and Belonging, to have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Wm Mullen, and to his Heirs and assigns to his and their use and Behoof forever.

In Testimony whereof, I William Irwin, Governor of the State of California have caused the Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the State of California to be hereunto affixed.
